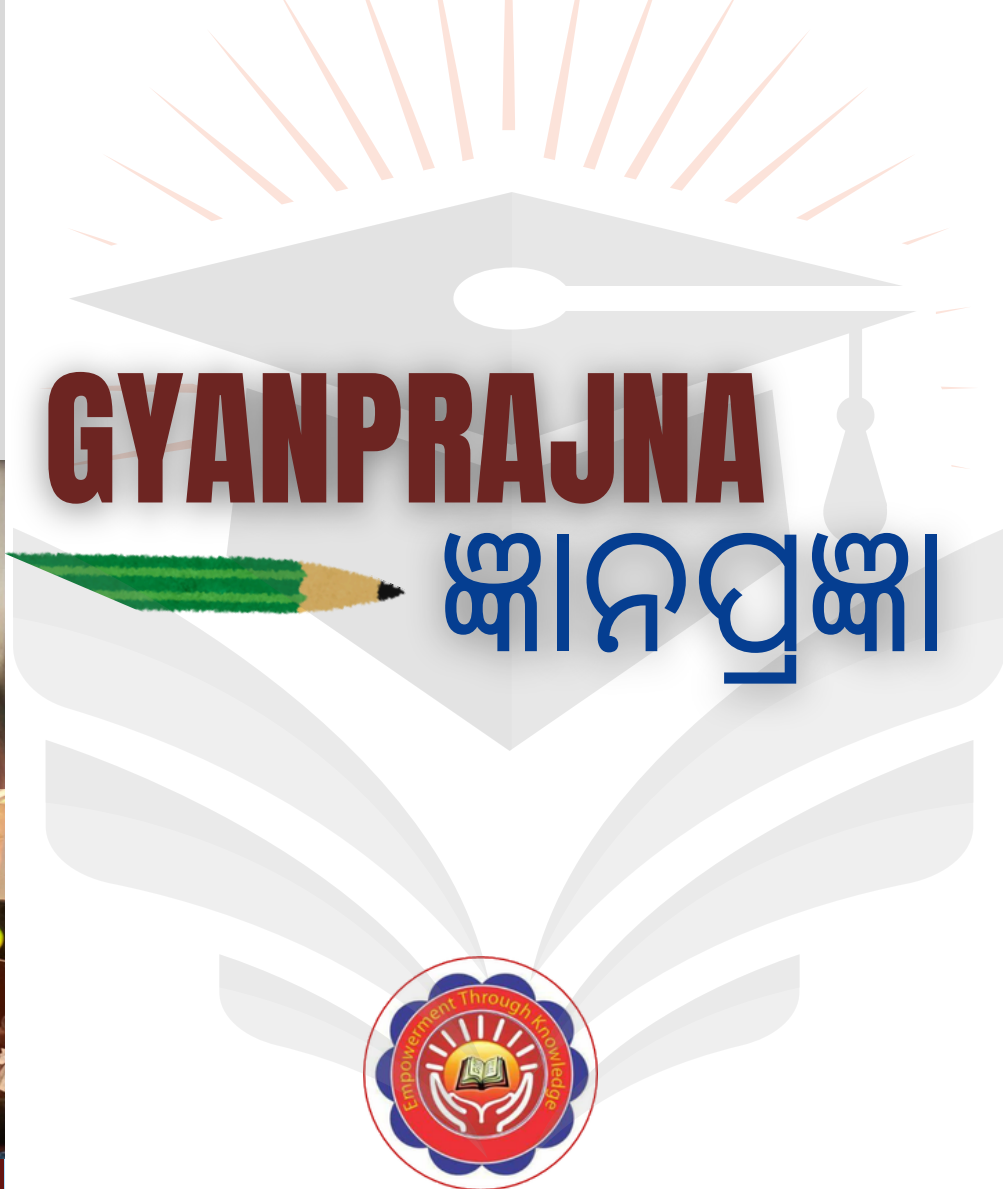

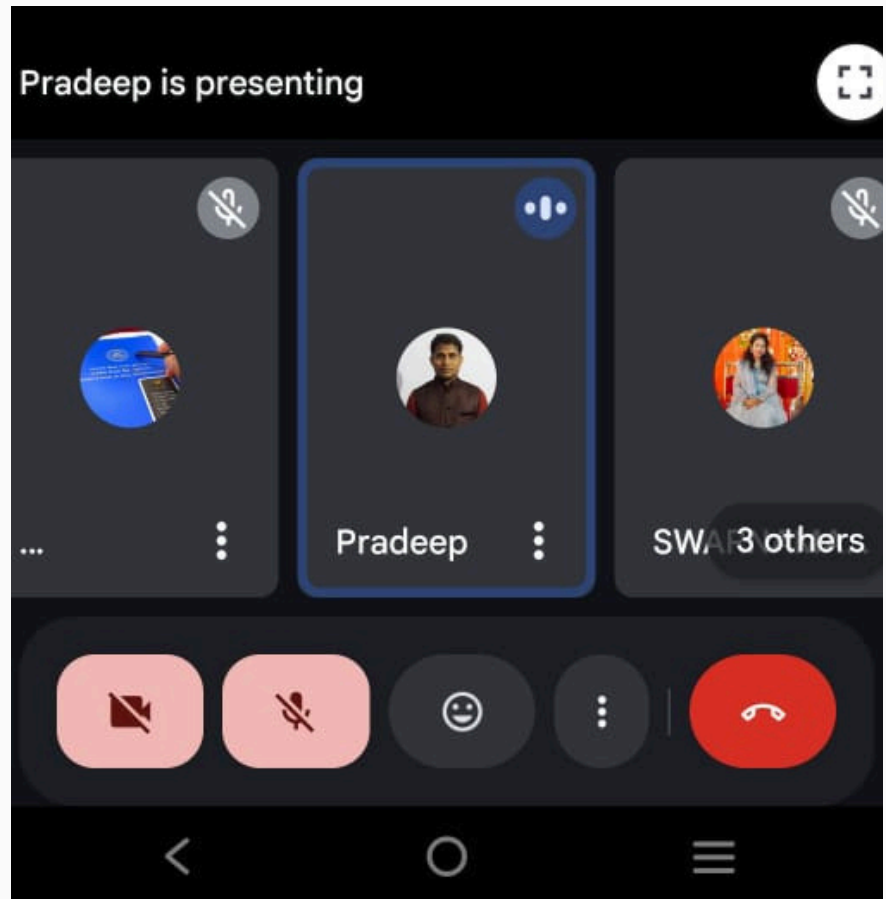
B : Core Group Strategic Meeting for the upcoming Year (2026) programmes
